YAV is committed to expanding opportunities for education and professional development, as well as providing a space for educators and artists to share their knowledge based on their skills, talents, and visions for the future. We invite arts educators, core curriculum educators who integrate the arts into their classrooms, and teaching artists to submit a proposal for YAV & ODU Inspiring Teachers Conference, which will take place on July 19, 2019.

What is the Inspiring Teachers Conference?

The YAV & ODU Inspiring Teachers Conference is an opportunity to bring together core curriculum and arts programming concepts in order to share successful teaching models with educators based on student statistics and successes achieved through arts integration. YAV recognizes that many educators and artists employ arts-integration techniques that can help students improve understanding and retention of material, and we wish to help spread that knowledge to other educators. The YAV & ODU Inspiring Teachers Conference is a low-cost way for educators to receive professional development credits that they are required to have.

How Does it Work?

Selected proposals will be invited to present at the YAV & ODU Inspiring Teachers Conference. Only Keynote Presenters will be paid a nominal fee for their workshop. Presenters will be asked to sign a contract that outlines the terms of the agreement between them and YAV. YAV will setup and manage registration, as well as setup and facilitate the online platform. The Presenter will be responsible for developing all materials, and retains intellectual property rights to their material.
