If selected, you will be contacted via phone and email and notified that we would like to schedule an audition presentation. Auditions are most often done as performances at an education site with an audience and do not constitute a performance fee. Artists located outside of the state of Virginia or beyond a reasonable distance may be asked to submit video documentation of their program.
